

Gordon and Shirley Brockmueller 2009-10 Scholarship

The Brockmueller Scholarship was created to recognize scholarship, leadership, and to reduce tuition costs. Awards are made each school year and may be presented to two or more students based on evaluation of a written essay by a selection panel including administration and the donors. This year there will be two, \$800 scholarships awarded and the amount will be credited against the student's tuition account.

All applicants for a Brockmueller Scholarship must complete a 250-500 word essay on the following question:

How will your studies at Freeman Academy prepare you for a life of service to Christ's church – in your home congregation, local community, pastoral ministry, voluntary service assignments, and/or overseas missions?

Selection Criteria:

- New or current students of Freeman Academy may apply.
- Students who WILL BE in grades 11 or 12 are eligible.
- Academic excellence.
- An interest in Christian ministry/service.
- Recipients may be eligible to apply and receive a scholarship annually.
