Class Rules

Homework Policy

Assignments are usually due by the next time class meets the following day. Five percent is docked from late papers. If a student is ill or absent, extensions will be made. If there are special circumstances, parents should notify me. If late papers become a problem, the student may need to stay in at noon or

after school to work on their homework. I teach the students to use folders to keep their daily assignments in. Organization is a big part of the fifth grade year.

Tardies

Students should be in class by 8:20 AM except for those riding buses. Usually this is not a problem. Children should not dawdle between classes. This is especially true for PE, art, music, and band. If necessary we may have to mark students tardy.

Snacks

Students will have a break everyday around 10:00 AM for snacks. They may bring nutritious snacks such as fruit, crackers and cheese, granola bars, etc. Please send very little candy. Save that for birthday treats or a special time. Popcorn should already be popped. Do not send microwave bags of popcorn to be popped. We don't have time for everyone to pop their bag at school. The students can store them in their lockers or in their cubby areas in our room. We encourage students to have a water bottle with a screw on lid to prevent spills. Old Gatorade or old juice bottles work well. No pop or juices are allowed. We will have those for a special treat sometime.

Afterschool

The school wishes to lock the building around 4:30 PM. Do not expect your child to stay in the school building to wait for later events such as children's choir, sport events, etc. Children

may stay here until 4:00 PM for help or to work on their schoolwork, but then I need time to plan for the next day. I cannot watch over your children after 4:00. Students could go to Pioneer Hall lobby to wait for you if necessary. They will be unsupervised though.
