While it seems summer has just begun, we are excitedly preparing for the 2010-11 school year!

Enclosed with this packet, you will find several forms requiring your prompt attention & return by July 15:

- 2010-11 Student Handbook (1 per student) – **signatures required on last page w/ return by 7/15/10**
- 2010-11 Acceptable Use for Technology Consent Form w/ Student Authorization Form (1 per student) – **signatures required on last page w/ return by 7/15/10**
- 2010-11 Medical Consent Form (1 per student) – **complete all information, leaving nothing blank obtain signatures & return by 7/15/10**
- 2010-11 South Dakota High School Activities Association Annual Parent & Student Consent Form (1 per Grade 7 – 12 student) - **return w/ signatures by 7/15/10**
- 2010-11 School Year Calendar (w/ slight revision) and Class Schedule (1 per family) – this primarily lists the 7th – 12th grade schedules since they have various teachers for each class.

Please return forms with all data completed and signatures recorded to the office by July 15.

If you did not receive enough of the above listed forms or misplaced any forms, the 2010-11 versions will soon be available online at our website: www.freemanacademy.org. Simply click on Resources, then Student, and you will find the various documents which you may print and complete.

Included in this packet is information from the Department of Education entitled “Parents’ Guide to the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA): Rights Regarding Children’s Education Records” and a sheet explaining FERPA for your information.

Again, please give your attention to these documents & return all of them to the business office on or before July 15. Please check to make certain all blanks are completed and all signatures obtained. As stated in the July newsletter, all release/acknowledgement forms need to be signed & submitted to the office prior to student computer accounts being set up. This is very important since your child(ren) will likely desire/need computer access the first day of school. If any of the students’ forms are not turned in until the first day of school, the students may need to wait a few days until their computer account can be set up which may affect their class participation.
