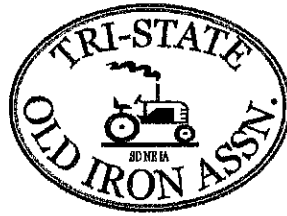
**Student Eligibility:**
