

# Tuition Reduction Agreement 2010-11

**Note: The Tuition Reduction Program will continue in 2010-11 under the same parameters as 2009-10. Please check the list before completing your hours.**

If parents agree to provide 90 hours of time to Freeman Academy annually, each full time enrolled student's tuition fee will be reduced by \$400. This provision lowers tuition costs for families and helps the school save personnel costs. Services and activities that apply:

## **Continued Volunteer Hours:**

Office support  
Classroom assistance  
Driving the School Bus (CDL required)  
Chairing fundraisers only  
Selling tickets or working at athletic events  
Clean up after sporting events  
Cleaning buildings, custodial assistance  
Fair booth hours

## **Discontinued hours:**

Repair and maintenance work  
Hours for keeping international students  
Baking for any fundraiser  
Schmeckfest  
Working with costumes  
Planting and harvesting crops  
Working at fundraisers, booster events

Some flexibility exists to do work on or off campus and during non-school hours, July-June.

Persons, other than parents, grandparents or immediate family members who might fulfill the tuition reduction contract must be approved by administration.

Activities which do not create income or provide for the daily needs of instruction and operation of the school, will not apply to the Tuition Reduction Agreement. Examples of activities which do not apply are:

- **Meetings or travel time** while serving on boards and committees of the school, museum, arboretum or auxiliary.

**Reductions in tuition fees will be shown on your billings as time sheets are turned in quarterly.**
